

## Franklin County Health Department



The Franklin County Health Department is accepting applications for a Contract Position to serve as an <u>Advanced Practice Registered Nurse-Family Nurse Practitioner.</u>
Less than 1,200 hours per year. Approximately 2-3 days a week or 20-22 hours per week.

This position will provide a variety of preventive health and communicable disease services, in accordance with State and Federal rules and regulations outlined in the Kentucky Department of Public Health's Clinical Service Guide and Administrative Reference. Work will generally be performed in the Medical Clinic setting.

## **General Duties include**:

This position serves under the direction of the Clinic Nurse Administrator. Responsibilities for this position include, but are not limited to:

Provide preventive health care such as well adult and well child exams, breast and cervical cancer screenings, school physicals, and sports physicals. Provide case management for breast and cervical cancer diagnosis and treatment. Diagnose and treat uncomplicated hepatitis C. Diagnose and treat STDs and other genital infections. Perform basic microscopy, to identify bacterial and fungal elements commonly present in vaginal specimens. Provide family planning services, including prescription of birth control methods and insertion and removal of LARC devices. Manage the diagnosis and treatment of patients with tuberculosis. Develop plans of care and provide patient education.

Minimum Education, Training or Experience: Graduate of an accredited school of nursing, graduate of an accredited Nurse Practitioner Program, and Current Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) licensure in Kentucky. Current in Basic Life Support (BLS). Minimum of 1-2 years providing direct patient services as an APRN in the family/primary care or Public Health setting.

**Special Requirements:** Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license and proof of automobile insurance. Must have computer skills in Word and Outlook.

**Starting Salary**: \$59/hour negotiable with additional experience.
