The Franklin County Health Department is accepting applications for a Full-Time (37.5hrs/wk) **Environmental Health Program Manager.**

General Duties include: This position serves under the direction of the Environmental Health Director, Jon Cambron. Responsibilities for this position include but are not limited to; Perform work of considerable complexity and difficulty in supervising a full range of comprehensive environmental health programs with extensive knowledge of the principles of science as applied to environmental health programs, including but not limited to an emphasis on Food Service Establishments, Food Borne Illness, Regulated Facilities, Plan Review, Rabies Prevention and Monitoring, and Public Pools. Responsibilities may also include the Onsite Wastewater, Public Nuisance and Private Well Water programs, as needed. Independently conducts technical, professional inspections and investigations relative to complaints or allegations of non-compliance of state and local Environmental Public Health laws and regulations to ensure compliance; conduct routine or specialized complex technical inspection, which could involve consumer complaints of regulated and non-regulated facilities; Negotiates abatement of non-compliant conditions, issues notices of violation and refers major problems to the appropriate supervisor in the event abatement is not achieved; provides consultation to the public and industry as requested; May develop and/or provide educational and technical seminars to assist operators in obtaining/maintaining required certifications. May provide on-the-job training for new or current personnel. Manage environmental health activities and manage technically sensitive environmental health activities requiring a higher degree of expertise. Work closely with the Environmental Health Director and other Environmentalists to ensure coverage in all program areas.

Minimum Education, Training or Experience: Bachelors Degree from a college or university with a minor or twenty-four (24) semester hours in environmental health, biological or physical science or registration as a Kentucky Environmental Specialist/Sanitarian under KRS 223 **and** four (4) years of experience as a health environmentalist performing inspections.

Special Requirements: Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license and proof of auto insurance.

Note: an individual upon employment must become registered under the provisions of KRS 223 to remain a permanent employee per Administrative Regulations 902KAR 8:080.

Starting Salary: \$27.16-\$33.78/hr. negotiable with additional experience. Grade 22

Benefits: Begin accruing Sick and Vacation time immediately after first period (3.5hrs each per pay period = 91 hours per year); 12 paid holidays a year; free \$20k life insurance policy; health insurance through Kentucky Employees Health Plan; participation in Kentucky Public Pensions Authority.
